During the month of April our Sunday Worship has been focused on more fully understanding the rich meanings of the word 'redemption' from God's Word. It's a fascinating word that should bring great humility for every Christ-Follower as we consider God's saving grace which purchased our freedom through the atoning work of Jesus.

For those of who belong to Jesus, we know that He literally purchased us away from the slave owner, satan. He came and did for us what we could not do for ourselves. The word redemption means to "buy back". Jesus purchased us so that we can be free and fully restored in relationship with our Heavenly Father. This is Amazing Grace and God's Word tells us that we are now joint heirs with Jesus as His brothers and sisters, fully entitled to all the riches of God's Kingdom!

Meanwhile, in our battle with the enemy here on earth, we still live in the presence of sin even though we've been set free from the penalty of sin. And outside of Jesus we are powerless against the enemy's schemes against us. However, through the power of the Holy Spirit who now lives in us, we are more than conquerors through the great work of our Redeemer, Jesus!

On April 28th I shared a description of what living a life that has been set free can look like. Many of you have asked me about that list so I'm giving it to you here. But always remember, this is the work of Christ through the Holy Spirit in you, not a work that you can accomplish on your own:

## <u>Through the Holy Spirit, because of God's Redemption through Jesus,</u> we are set free so that we can:

- 1. Love others the way that God loves them.
- 2. Experience a deep and abiding joy every day of our lives.
- 3. Find peace in life instead of turmoil at every turn.
- 4. Become patient with the process and path of life that God has us on.
- 5. Speak and exhibit a kindness towards others that is uncommon in the world.
- 6. Develop a goodness about our character that reflects the life of Jesus.
- 7. Deal with others gently instead of harshly and abruptly.
- 8. Become more faithful to the mission that Christ has given to us.
- 9.Become self-controlled through the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit who is alive in us when we are tempted by things of the world that do not give honor and glory to God.

Let's go and LIVE in this freedom, that the whole world will know!


